"When the Lord restored the fortunes of Zion, we were like those who dream."

Dear Central UMC members and friends.

In 2017 we launched our "Dreams to Reality" capital campaign to support the vision of creating affordable housing on our church property. God gave us a vision bigger than we could accomplish on our own. I am so grateful for the leadership at the Arlington Partnership for Affordable Housing (APAH) who believed in our vision and were willing to help us make that dream a reality. In just a few months residents will start moving into those brand-new committed affordable housing units that APAH will own and operate.

As our leadership board continues to work on our plans to relaunch our congregation's ministries in Ballston we're once again dreaming of the future reality God has in mind for us.

During the season of Advent, the scripture readings that highlight how God prepared people for the birth of Jesus feature people who were dreamers. Sometimes the text tells us of a literal dream, like Joseph had one night, where God gave a clear message to a person. Other times, it features people like the Magi who imaged a transformed world and knew how to look for the signs that God was at work. Starting December 2, during worship each week we're going to encounter the story of some who received and responded to God's dreams for the world. In Advent, we step into the mystery and awe of God's dreams and pray they shape our reality.

This worship series for the dreamers in all of us—those who dream of a deeper connection with God and those who dream of a better world. It's for those who dream of comfort and for those who have given up on their dreams. It's for those whose dreams have been crushed and for those who show us that dreams take time. Join us in worship as we dream alongside prophets and angels, Mary and the Magi. We worship in person on Saturdays at 10:30 a.m., virtually on Sundays at 10:30 a.m., and if you miss a sermon you can listen to our podcast by visiting sermons.cumcballston.org.


**Pat Barham** - Thank you to the 28 people who ordered the White House Ornaments totaling 112. With these purchases Central made a total of \$341.60. Enjoy your ornaments.

**Steve Barham** – Thanks to all those who contributed to the annual CROP WALK. I raised \$1,373 from the members of Central and friends. All totaled over \$29,000 was collected in Arlington of which 25% stays in the county. Nationwide there were 2,550 teams that raised \$2,741,753 so far for 2023. Funds raised help people in need with no restrictions based on faith or beliefs.

**The Mission Team** – Thanks to all who contributed to the toy drive in November for area children to have a nicer Christmas.



The original project cost was anticipated as \$9.1 million for the church's share of the construction costs. With various change orders and anticipated change orders, we expect the total cost to come in at \$9.5 million. Considering the impact of Covid and construction material inflation pricing we are doing well. In addition, the church has paid some costs directly and will have some fit-out expense yet to come but we should finish close to the budget considering contingencies and offsets.



**SANCTUARY** 

We are in the process of making furniture selections, interior design components, signage and other finish elements. The tile for the labyrinth is arriving shortly and installation will begin in a couple of weeks. A mockup of the stained glass windows will be available in a week. The backlight panels have already been installed. This long exile will soon be over in 100 days and counting.
